

Fisheries Technicians-Fort Drum, NY

POSITION: Fisheries technicians (2) are needed to assist with fisheries and hydrology work in Fort Drum, New York. Incumbents will be employed by Colorado State University's Center for Environmental Management of Military Lands (CSU CEMML).

LOCATION: Fort Drum, New York. Fort Drum is a United States Army installation 10 miles northeast of Watertown, New York and in close proximity to Canada, the Thousand Islands, and the Adirondack Park.

PRIMARY DUTIES: The technicians will assist in surveys for fish and benthic macroinvertebrates and in the collection of physical and chemical water properties from lakes and streams. Technicians will also help to assess hydraulics and hydrology by collecting culvert measurements and flow data. Work will include, but is not limited to: electrofishing, collecting stream flows, assessing culverts, tagging and tracking fish, gill and trap netting, collecting water chemistry data, and performing stream habitat assessments.

QUALIFICATIONS: Technicians should have least an AS or AAS degree or upper division standing in fisheries, hydrology, biology, ecology, natural sciences or a related field. A BS/BA degree is preferred, but not required. A valid driver's license is required.

The successful candidate will have experience performing a variety of fisheries and hydrology work. Applicants should be in good physical condition and willing to work long hours in all types of weather and habitat conditions. Experience with boats and a working knowledge of Global Positioning Systems (GPS) is a plus.

WAGES: \$15.49/hour, depending on qualifications and experience. Housing is not provided.

DURATION OF EMPLOYMENT: Approximately mid-May – mid August 2018. Longer periods may be available based on funding
